

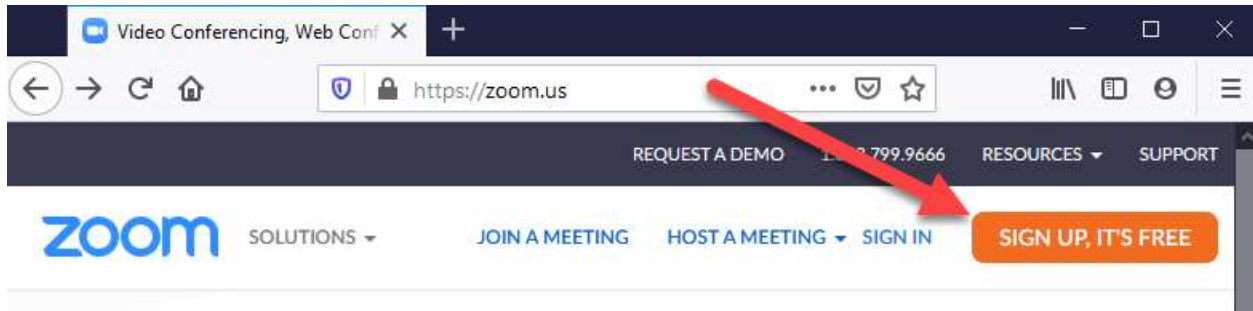
## Step-by-Step Guide to Creating a Zoom Basic Account

Here is a step-by-step pictorial introduction to creating a Zoom Basic account.

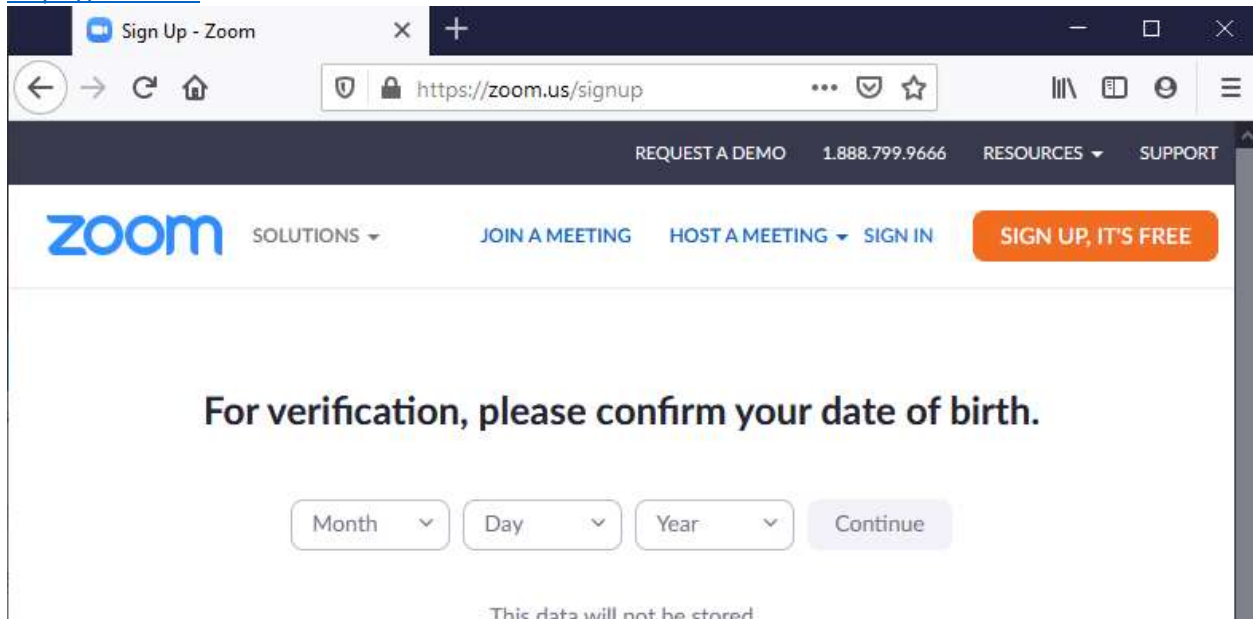
First, start a browser and navigate to zoom.us. Here is what that looks like on Windows (Apple, iOS, and Android might look a bit different, but the basic steps are the same):



You may see the browser display something like this if you have not already used Zoom on the computer or browser you are using now. Zoom always tests your connection to determine whether an older version of its software is present on your current computer connection, and will update it automatically if needed.



When you click or touch the SIGN UP, IT'S FREE button, Zoom will ask you for your birth date (to determine whether you say that you are older than 18). Notice the padlock icon to the left of <https://zoom.us> – it means that the connection to the Zoom website is secure.



Go ahead and fill in your birth date month, day, and year. The Continue button will turn blue, so click or touch it:

On the next screen, Zoom will ask for your email address (the instruction asks for your work email, but any personal email address will work just as well; use the email address at which you receive LWV messages). If you already have a Zoom account on a different computer, go ahead and sign in by clicking the Sign in link to use it, rather than creating a new Zoom account. Or if you wish, sign in with your Google or Facebook user name and password:
