

THE DEADLINE FOR EITHER REGISTERING TO VOTE OR UPDATING YOUR VOTER STATUS IS OCTOBER 7!

If, since the last election, you have moved, changed your marital status and/or name, you can verify your voter status by logging on either of these web sites:

- Secretary of State (SOS) at ohiosos.gov/elections/voters **or**
- Wood County Board of Elections (BOE) at co.wood.oh.us/boe or just Wood County Board of Elections

VOTER REGISTRATION

ACCEPTED IDENTIFICATION:

- Unexpired Ohio drivers license or State ID card number OR
- The last four digits of your social security number

NOT ACCEPTED TO REGISTER TO VOTE:

- Military ID, a copy of a Photo ID, utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document

CASTING YOUR BALLOT OPTIONS

ABSENTEE BALLOT:

Request BALLOT from the SOS or BOE web sites. Return completed form by:

- US mail or at BOE drop box **NO LATER** than 7 days before the election.

DEADLINES

- By USPS mail postmarked by the day before the election or
- Hand-delivered to BOE at Wood County Court House by 7:30 pm on Election Day

TRACK YOUR BALLOT REQUEST at BOE.

EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING:

Begins October 8 daily to **SUNDAY** prior to Election Day.

Hours vary, refer to BOE web site for detailed hours.

ID accepted: Unexpired Ohio driver's license or State ID, U.S. Military, or U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs card, OH Nat'l Guard card or U.S. Passport.

ELECTION DAY:

IDS ACCEPTED:

- Unexpired Ohio driver's license or State ID card , U.S. Military, or U.S. Dept of Veterans Affairs card, Ohio National Guard card, or U.S. Passport.

POLLING PLACES MAY BE DIFFERENT FROM THE LAST TIME YOU VOTED

- Verify Polling locations at BOE.
